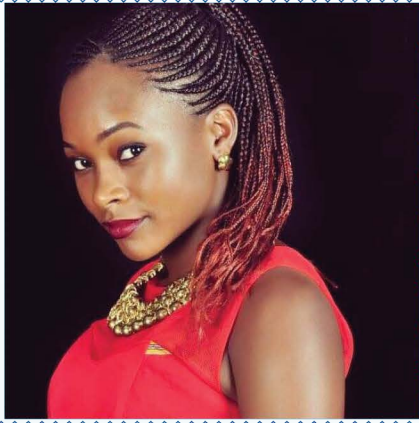

HOW DOES A HUMANIST MANAGE LIFE WITHOUT A GOD.

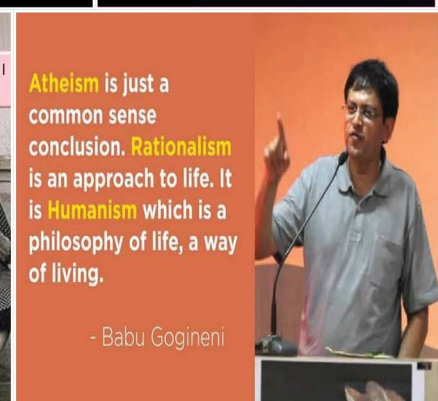
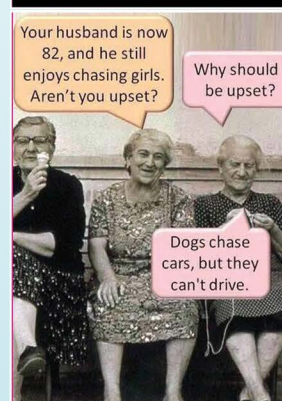
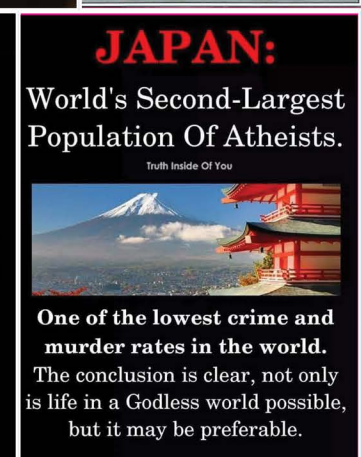
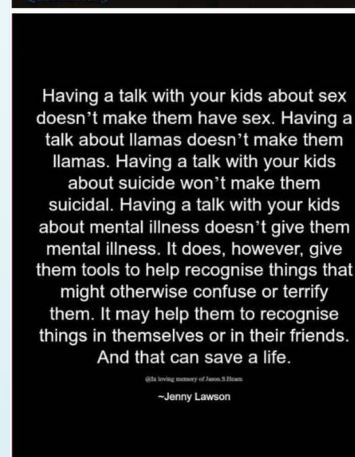
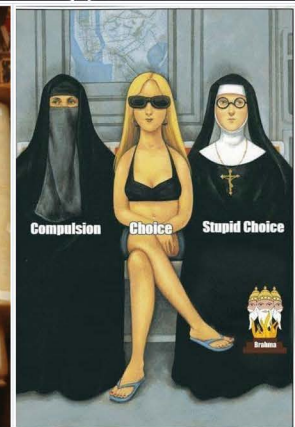
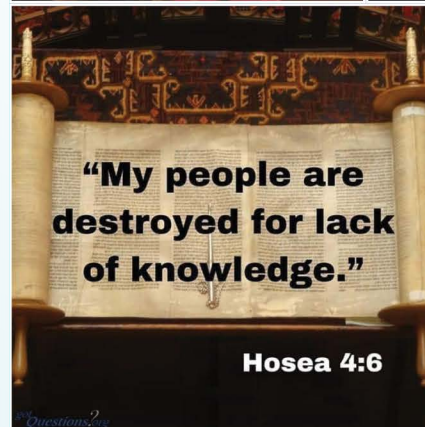
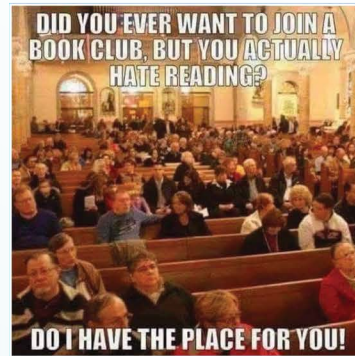

MORALITY : DO RELIGIOUS LEADERS HAVE GROUND TO DETERMINE WHAT IS MORAL OR NOT?

Living in Africa and growing up in Uganda exposed me to a lot of religious indoctrination. As a child, I grew up seeing Catholic Priests as role models and as an embodiment of what morality means. They were humble, soft spoken, meek as sheep, they never had women at least from my childish perspective, they were smartly dressed and they acted as the would be true custodians of Godly morality. During prayers, they always peaches tous the value in loving one another, the need in caring for each other and they emphasised that we are all mad in God's image and our bodies are temples of God. They lived in huge cathedrals, owned big farms, ate good food and drove posh cars. I can comfortably confess that I loved being a priest my self for I thought that being a priest was being next to God and was a getway to heaven.

The priests had previllages that the ordinary folks could not get. The worshippers always gave them, only, sometimes brought food, animals and other related gifts as a token of appreciation to a people serving God. It was extremely inspiring to be a priest and be in a position to serve my community. Above all, during the rebaration war that brought Museven to power, the priests in my area kept the community together and I don't remember an incident when they were attacked by either government soldiers or the liberators.

The point is priesthood was highly respected, exempted from paying taxes and generally accorded respect and many times I would observe that when we boarded public buses or attended community functions, religious leaders such as priests, Imams, Nuns and reverends would be given special seats in most cases sitting infront of the pack. That was the extent to which religious leaders had previllages and leverage over other members of the community.

For decades knew priests as the custodians of morality in the wold over, they twilight people how to behave, they preached to is what is good and bad, and showed us through their scriptures what behaviour and thoughts that can take one to either heaven.

As a teenager, I observed that the priests had an extra role of offering counselling and guidance services as well as hearing confessions from people who had sinned. I also knew that these very priests being the custodians of morality, and being God's representatives on earth, had extra powers to forgive sin Thus as a believer then, whenever we discussed the theme morality, it was the religious leaders and especially the catholic priests who would come to my mind.

When I was seventh ears old, I began reading widely about the history of Catholic Church, Christianity and Islam. My readings, exposed me to a different set of reality. It was then that I came to discover that the abrahamic religions especially Islam and Christianity were founded by the sword, maintained by the sword and spread through violence, terror, tyranny and blood bath. I was. Shocked reading through the inquisition times I was to learn that chrisatiam crusaders went about killing non believers and they had the blessings of the Leadership of the Catholic Church. Equally so, I learnt that Islam was preached through Jihadism and many people lost their lives.

Iread that the priests that started the Catholic Church married many women and fathered countless children until when the Catholic Church was in turmoil that a sex tax was introduced and priests were outlawed from marrying women and all women without husband were sold into slaverly. The birth of the Pentecostal church in Great Britain was more fascinating and equally challenging. That a disagreement between a king and a pope over a king's Desiree to Marty another woman and her a successor and the pope's refusal to grant permission to the catholic king then was enough spark for the king of England to start the Church of England and for all purposes and intent , the king remained the political head of a religious institution. This is the Church of England as we know it today that has thousands of branches of what we know as the Protestant churches in Uganda.

What we note here is the sad departure from my original understanding of morality. That religious leaders would sanction war, bless slave traders, colonisers and imperialists and world participate in the deadly world wars blessing the soldiers and their guns with trademark phrases such as “praise the liars and pass the amnition” was a mind blowing revelation that I could not swallow with ease.

Growing up, I realised that religious leaders were never the true custodians of morality as I had understood it in my childhood. The more I observed the more I became sceptical and I finally lost my faith. As a lawyer working with a humanist organisation (HALE Ltd) and as Legal assistant working with Uganda Law society handling probonal cases, the over ten years in service has exposed me to the bitter reality. I have handled cases of top religious leaders who sexually molested children defiled teenagers and impregnated them, denied parentalhood of children they have produced and physically assaulted their victims because they have come to us to complain.

Often have been threatened by some of these culprits and others have offered to bribe their way to freedom. This we have refused to do and we have continued to champion the rights of the marginalised. Some of our cases have been documented in news papers and featured on public television as we expose these uncouth religious leaders who continue to be shamed and displayed to the world for who they are .

Minister Nakiwala Kiyinji has handled some of these recent cases on camera especially we have encouraged the victims to report to our office. There are notorious offenders such as pastor Augustine Yiga who is on record to have sexually abused more than five victims among which were outrightly defiled. There has been a case of shake Umar who has defiled three of his clients who go to him seeking healing prayers .

The above is just a tip of the iceberg. The rot among religious leader is simply far too much, surprisingly these very religious leaders continue pretending to be the custodians of morality and condemn everyone for being immoral but them selves.

As a gay Rights activist I have had cases where some of these religious leaders especially catholic priests and Pentecostal pastors have sexually abused boys in their charge and even when the evidence against them is overwhelming they can not simply own up and atleast accept to take care of the medication and rehabilitation of their victims. Ironically, some of these very priests use their platforms to attack homosexuality and fuel homophobia something that makes our work very hard. Homosexuality for example is treated as a sin and evil and something unacceptable by their God. These very priests are at the center of promoting homophobia and calling upon people to discriminate, torture and kill homosexuals. That is there understanding of morality.

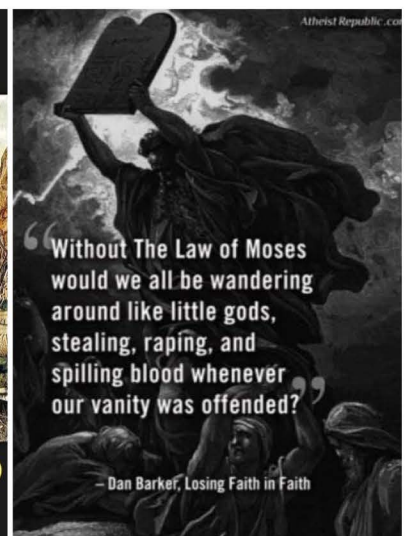
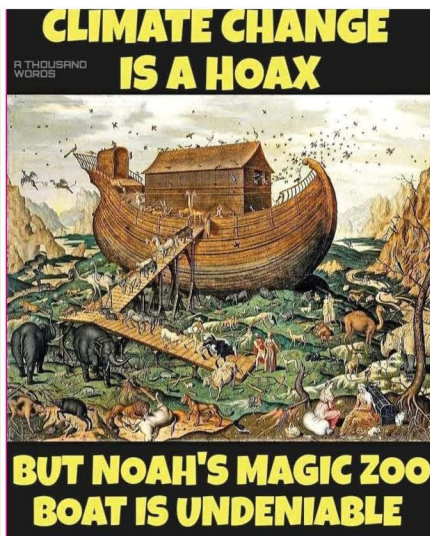
As humanists, we don't think that personal morality should be a target for the law unless one's immoral actions cause suffering. We don't need 10 commandments to know what is good and to avoid what is bad. To live a good life, we don't guidance of religious leaders or their moral code. But rather, we should go by the golden rule which in part states “ Do not do unto others as you would that they should do unto you” in other words Soto others what you would wish to be done to you . To me, morality should be good, reciprocal and utilitarian in a way that it promotes social Justice and enables us to live in a better world.

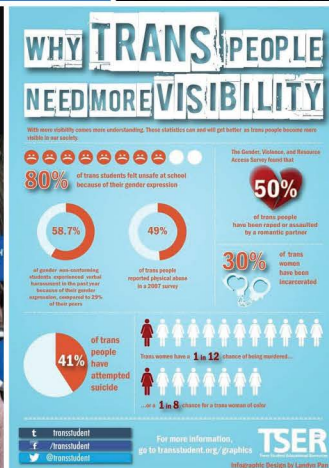
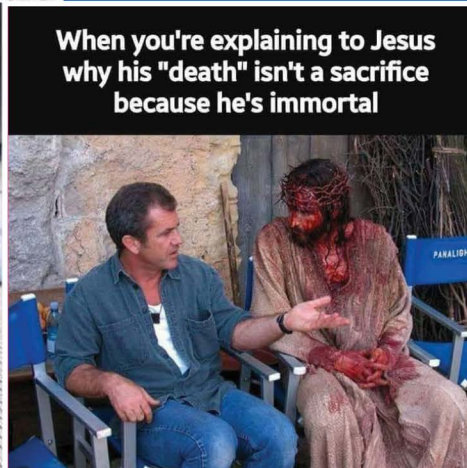
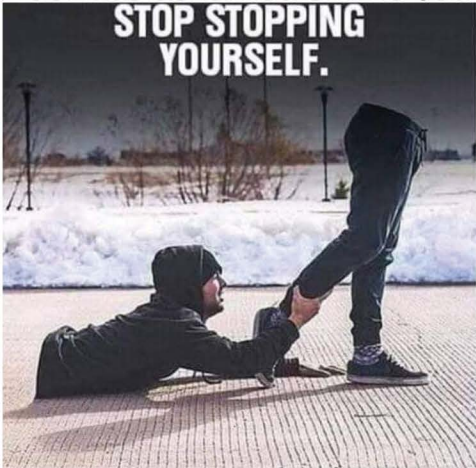

Dear Readers of the OTM,
Allow me share my thoughts with you on the understanding of Morality. It Should be noted that the word "Moral" etymologically comes from the Greek word "moralis" which means proper behaviour of a person in the society. In the literally meaning, it pertains to manners, behaviours or conduct.

In the same Accord, we need to define what Morality means. It therefore refers to the system through which we determine right and wrong conduct that is to say; the guide to good or right conduct.

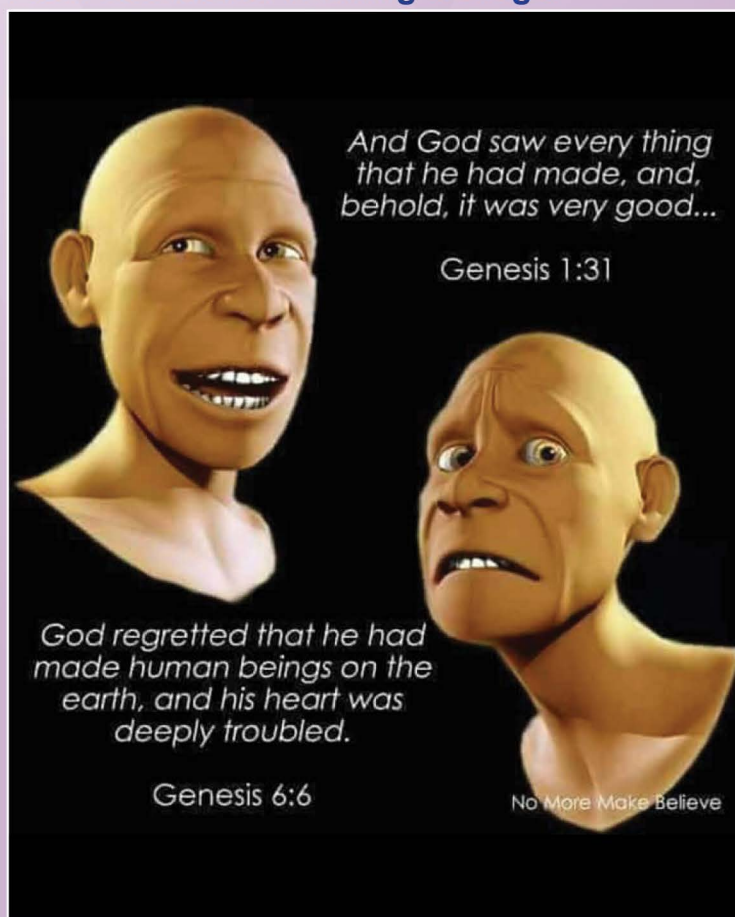
So the notion of how we ought to behave and the reality of how we do behave bare varied and real Morality behaves in accordance with one's perception of Morality.

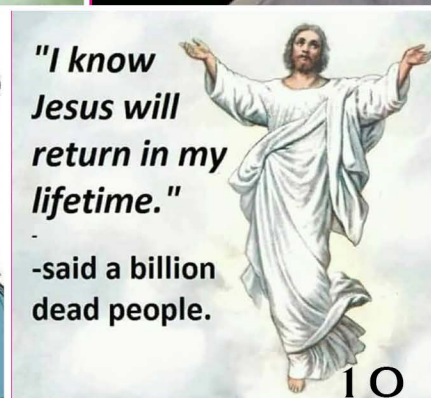
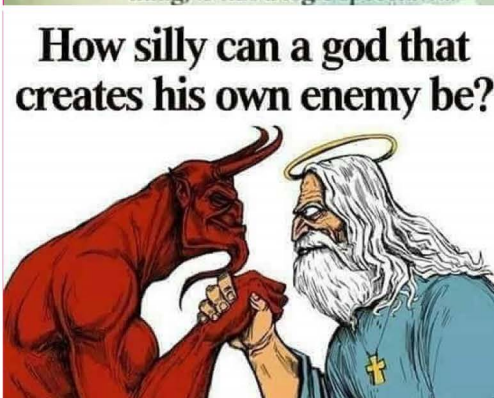
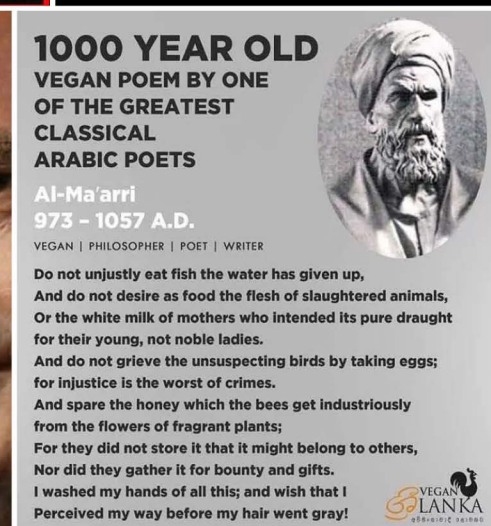
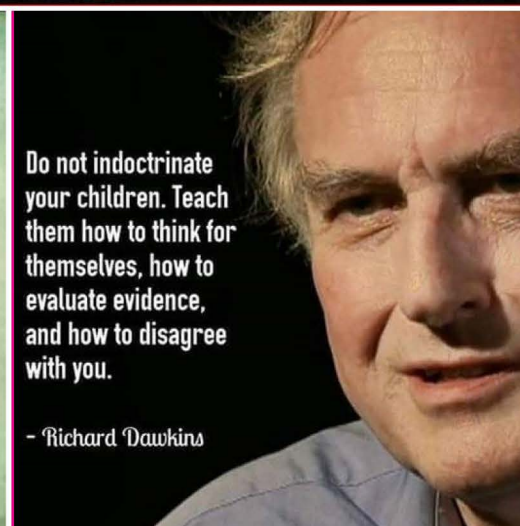
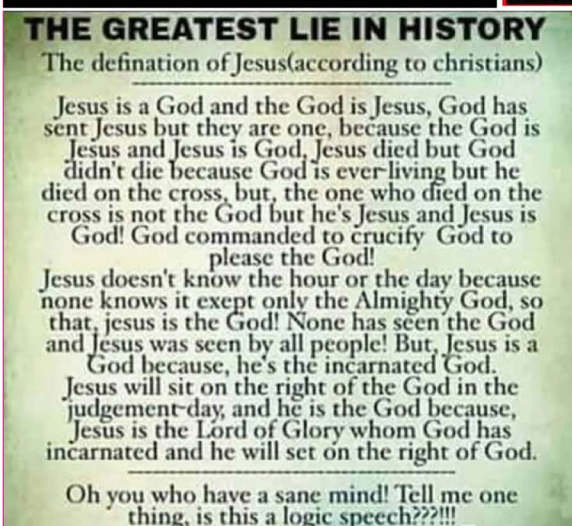
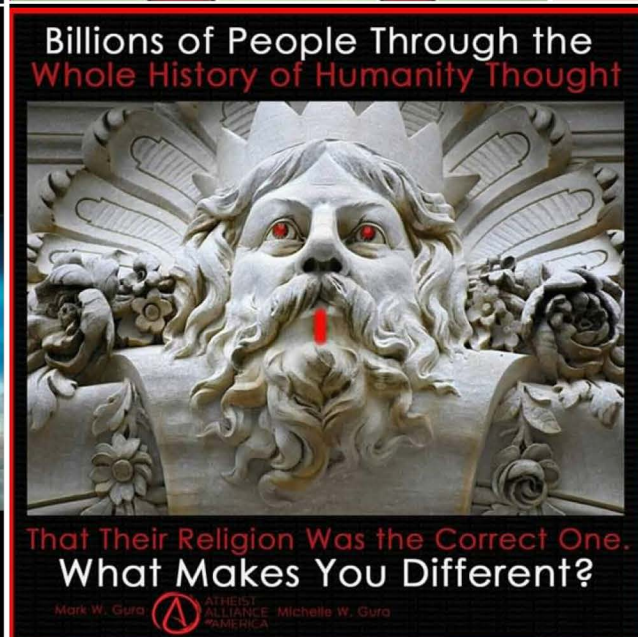
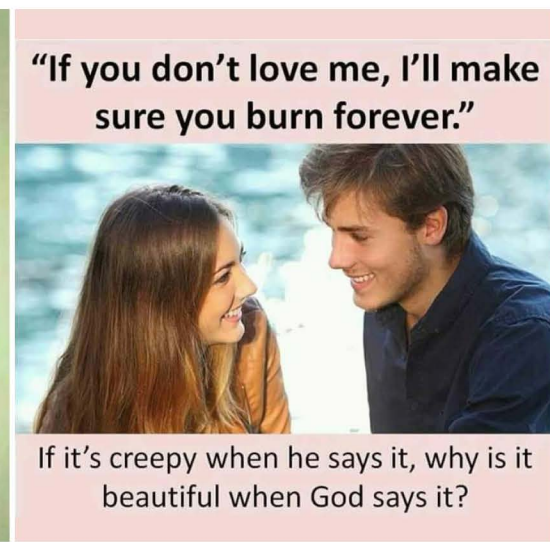
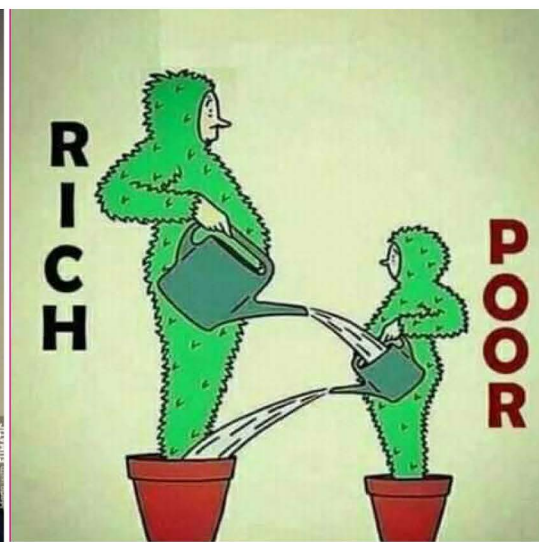
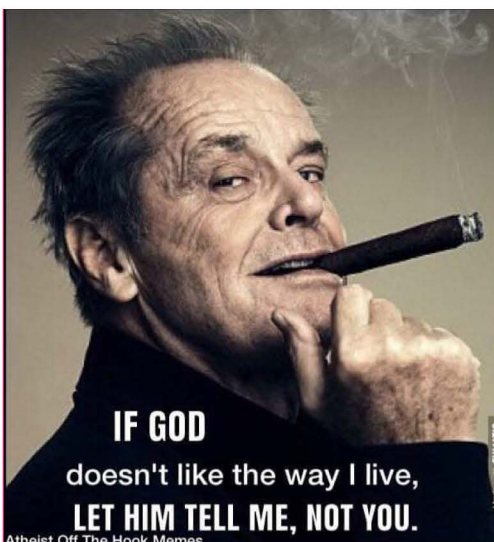
The system of standards used to produce honest, decent and ethical results are considered moral.

Boko Haram does this so has Zamfara state under its drive to establish Sharia in the early 2000s.

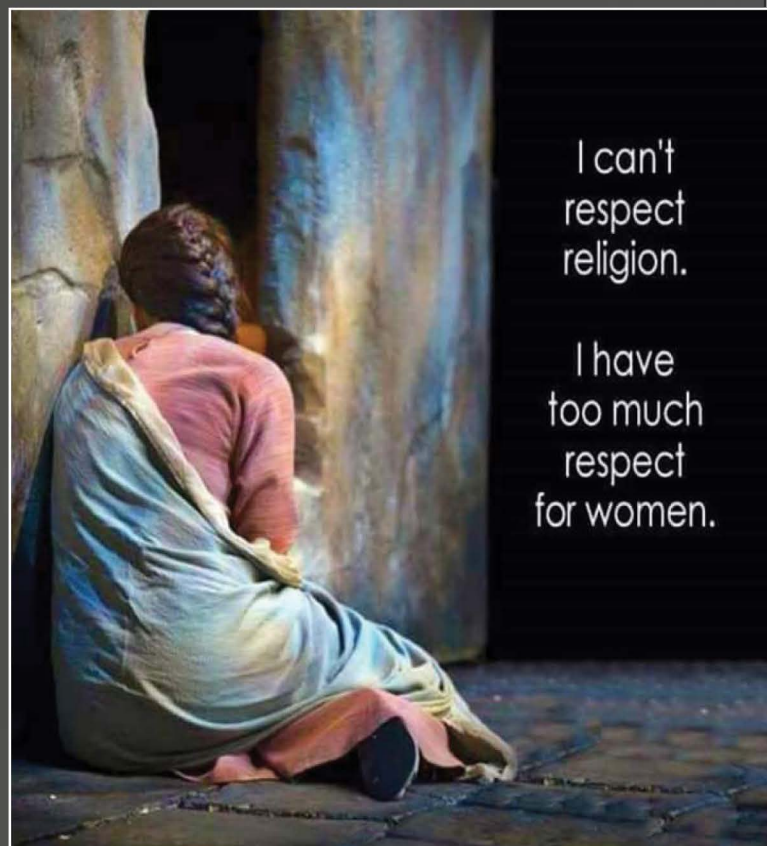
What's the difference between sharia and the bible, absolutely no difference because they are from the same source.

, we should regard all creatures as we regard our own self" (Lord Mahavira, 24th Tirthankara). They brand themselves as the custodians of the moral campus, they are the people to look up to and we see what their god requires the rest of us the weaker, mortal beings emulate. They tell us what is good and what is bad, they tell us what defines our destiny, what qualifies us to either go to hell or heaven.

They all start in the most humble of ways. They start with small congregations, sometimes with no built churches (call them churches without walls) in rented premises and in most cases, make shift churches. Then they preach the word of their version of god with passion, persuasion, and in no time, they have ten, one hundred, hundreds and thousands of followers.

They have a shepherd who is religiously trusted by the sheep that see them from the humble beginnings and it is such founder church members that are later to bear witness of how their god works miracles because they would have seen a church starting with family members and friends and growing into a huge enterprise that eventually attract thousands of worshippers and the god business empire blossoms and grows out of bounds like a bush fire. Their message is focused on selling one main brand, Jesus Christ the son of God. The Jesus merchandise comes in a package that includes faith healings, "miracle" performances,

exorcism, prosperity gospel books and magazines authored by themselves etc. They also trade in other items such as the so called holy handkerchiefs, water, olive oil from Israel, and some

even sell merchandize and edible items from their business ventures including rice, under garments, bread, salt etc. They claim that the products sold at church are holy and blessed and they carry blessings to those that use them. It should not therefore surprise you that majority of their worshippers (I refer to them as the sheeple) buy these products and ridiculous prices, sometimes 15 times more that what the item is sold at the local store. To the church goer, that is not thuggery, it is supporting God's ministry.

The owners of these churches, call them Ministers, or Pastors, or Bishops or Evangelists etc, always convince their gullible sheeple to donate money to the church to support establishment of church owned radio and television stations so that the word of god can be preached wide and far. The faithful worshippers raise the money through total sacrifice. Some sell their properties, others donate their properties directly to the church and the church will sell the property to raise money.

I have known individuals who have dedicated half of their salary to church development for years, there are some who have foregone meals, resorted into fasting and donated the saved money to the church. I am not talking about just a few individuals, I am talking about thousands of individuals doing exactly that, raising money through super personal sacrifices to raise money that can be taken to support church development. The church leaders fervently encourage the sheeple to pray for miracles to happen and their smoothened pressure cleverly works on the psyche of the believers that they easily convince them to attend morning prayers, lunch time and overnight prayers because it is important to keep a personal relationship with god and the more you pray the more it becomes easier for God to answer your prayers.

They are encouraged to pray to get employed, to get better jobs and to get miraculous healings. This obviously transparent nonsense disturbs my conscience a great deal. Watching these pastorpreneurs uttering statements dripping with intellectual dishonesty and moral cowardice, I have always had a hard time wrapping my head to appreciate why a people can stoop so low down the logical ladder and swallow every lie the pastorpreneurs trade as they promote intellectual dishonesty and laziness and yet they continue to proudly do so for generations, unchallenged.

Theirs is a full time job, preaching the word of god and encouraging the sheeple to sow the seed to do god's work. So it follows that the sheeple contributes the funds, Radio and TV stations are established to further spread the word of god. Who then owns the Church Media and who is it accountable to? Does it make any profits, does it allow advertisers, do the sheeple that contributed to the establishment of the media have their adverts aired free of charge?

The sheeple does not have the courage to ask the hard questions because it is immoral to question those that god has anointed. Meanwhile, they see their pastors rise from rags to riches, they gradually own palaces for homes, own the most luxurious cars, take their children to study in Europe and the US and some even own private jets. Is it surprising that many of the richest pastors in the world today are based in Africa? Bishop David Oyedepo, a Nigerian born pastorpreneur has a net worth of \$150M and with over a hundred branches of his church version spread all over the world earning him hundreds of thousands of dollars each day. He among others owns private jets and stays a luxurious life that his sheeple only dreams about in heaven.

Bishop Oyedepo is not alone in the rich club, he is ranked with his colleagues in the god business that include Bishop Adeboye, T.B Joshua, Alph Lukau, Ayadele Oritsejafor, Chris Okotie, Chris Oyakhilome, Mathew Ashmolowo, Ray Macculay and Ubert Angel among others. The most successful pastorpreneurs can be traced in West and South Africa. It pays to be a smart pastor, convincing thousands of gullible sheeple selling them an invisible product and promising them heaven can be a rewarding venture.

Uganda's version of these pastorpreneurs can be seen in pastors such as Samuel Kakande,

Joseph Sserwadda, Robert Kayanja and the new stubborn entrant, Aloysius Bugingo. Our version of pastorpreneurs are not doing bad financially either, some like Bugingo have amassed unaccounted for wealth just in less than ten years. Thus if their God business continues to flourish, be sure as day follows light that they will soon be owning private jets just like their inspirational pastors in West and South Africa.

Do these pastorpreneurs talk about morality? Yes. They are in fact the enforcers of god's version of morality. Their message is the same: they condemn homosexuality and tell their congregation that their version of god is punishing African countries for being tolerant to homosexuals.

They often say that regimes that tolerate homosexuals are agents of the devil and that the end times are near. They preach against feminism, secularism, atheism, humanism and all "isms" that tend to question the moral code as presented in the 'holy' books. Some are aggressively intolerant to even other religions branding other religious groupings as devil worshippers and positioning their own brand of religion as the most correct and the only path that leads to heaven and eternal happiness.

Do these pastors directly condemn human rights violations at the hands of the most corrupt and dictatorial regimes in their countries? Hell No. They smartly choose to leave what belongs to Caesar to Caesar of course as business people, they know it well that it is important to share a bed with regime of the day as a cushion for their own safety and prosperity. Many own private guards supplied to them by regime handlers and the sheeple will not ask why men of god should be guarded by soldiers in the first place?

Take a look at where most of these churches are located. They are built in areas that are dwellings of the most poor, less educated and in places where highly superstitious people stay. With a people having hundreds of problems, the prosperity gospel is not hard to sell. There are several red flags that would definitely attract attention of a critically thinking people but the

majority of the theists are generally blind believers, they pay less attention to the most critically observable realities such as a hitherto poor pastor amassing wealth over night and at their own expense but instead, through blind faith, they focus on how much their own faith can get them to the wealth the pastor enjoys. To them, it is through prayers that the pastors become wealth and equally, it will take prayers for them to receive the blessings of god and become wealth too. It is as simple as that. To this end, can we still say that our pastorpreneurs are moral beings that our people should look up to for inspiration, to determine how to live their lives? Depending on your definition of morality being subjective to a number of factors, I may not be the most qualified to dismiss your point of view in regard to these pastorpreneurs but regardless

of the simple mantra that they keep championing, I do not see them as a people even remotely qualified to set the benchmarks on which morality can be defined.

THE BIOLOGY OF HOMOSEXUALITY AND TRANS SEXUALITY

An Analysis by ABRAR HASSEN.



Writing this piece is no easy task for me as I have only recently started looking into the complex phenomena of homosexuality and transsexuality. But I want to make full use of this opportunity to share what I have learnt so far. These phenomena are still not fully understood and are being studied. The purpose of this piece is to present very briefly what science has uncovered and thereby encourage the reader to do further research.

Firstly, let's talk about homosexuality. Homosexual behaviour is observed in a wide variety of animals. Starting from dogs to sheep. This observation alone makes it obvious that there is a biological component that determines homosexuality. It cannot simply be a result of culture or choice. But even if it was, it still would not be wrong as it is a consenting relationship between 2 adults and no one is being hurt.

There are genetic factors as well as environmental factors that give rise to homosexuality. It has been observed that if one twin is homosexual, the chances that the other twin will also be homosexual is greater in case of identical twins than in case of non identical twins. In other words, identical twins are both more likely to be both homosexuals than non identical twins. Identical twins share 100% of their DNA and non identical twins only share 50% of their DNA.

So the observations are what we would expect if genes played a role in homosexuality. But it is often the case that one identical twin is homosexual but the other is heterosexual. So DNA cannot be the only factor that play a role in homosexuality. The environment also plays a role. One twin study estimated that genes played a role of 30% and the environment around 70%. [1]

In recent years, specific parts of the human DNA have been shown to be related to homosexuality. Homosexual people have similarities in certain parts of their DNA. Two such parts are 8q12 and Xq28. [2] Besides DNA, hormonal factors have also been shown to play a role in homosexuality.

Women who have been exposed to increased level of androgen (a hormone) are more likely to be homosexual. [3]

Homosexuality is an important part of nature. Homosexual members do not reproduce themselves but they take care of their nieces and nephews and allow more reproduction by their heterosexual relatives. This is called kin selection or gay uncle hypothesis. Homosexual behavior also helps to form strong alliances among members of the same sex which is advantageous for survival. This has been observed in apes. [4]

It is a well perpetuated myth that homosexual people are more likely to suffer from STDs than heterosexual people. But the reality is, this risk is higher specifically for male homosexuals who

practice anal sex. The risk of STD can be avoided by regular medical check ups and contraceptives. However, there is another factor in play here. That is discrimination. Homosexual people have poorer access to health care and they feel uncomfortable sharing their sexual identity with their doctors for fear of discrimination. This is an important factor that makes homosexual people vulnerable to diseases. [5] The study I provided has been done in America.

One can expect the situation to be much worse in countries such as Uganda or Bangladesh. Being a student of medicine, I personally feel that the entire field should be ashamed of this.

Now let's talk about transsexuality. Transsexuality is a condition where a person identifies as a member of the opposite gender. They feel that they are trapped in the body of the wrong gender. This is a legit biological condition. Trans people are not pretenders as is wrongly assumed by many people.

There is a respectable amount of evidence that the brains of transsexuals are wired like that of the gender that they identify with. A man who identifies as a woman has a brain resembling a female brain. Two regions of the brain, striae terminalis and the interstitial nucleus of the hypothalamus are known to be sexually dimorphic.

That is, they are different in men and women. These parts of the brains of trans women (man to woman transitioners) resemble the female brain instead of male brain. This has been observed even before the trans person has started hormone therapy to transition to a woman. [6] There are also genetic factors that causes transsexuality. The gene coding for androgen receptor is defective in man to woman transsexuals. [7]

One important thing that should be stated is that transsexuality is no longer considered a mental disorder.[8] A better understanding of the condition made us realize that it makes no sense to classify it as a mental illness. So the WHO, American Medical Association and American Psychiatric Association no longer considers transsexuality to be a mental illness.[9] It may be a bit hard to grasp for some people but it is simple really.

Transsexual people are not delusional. A trans woman (man who turned woman) does not think she has a uterus. She does not think she has the body of a woman. She is well aware of her male body. But she feels that she is trapped in a wrong body. This is an accurate self perception because as discussed earlier, her brain resembles a female brain. Female brain placed in a male body. There is nothing delusional about her self perception.

Some people often point out that the suicide rate among trans people is high. And they use this fact to falsely claim that trans people are mentally ill. But this is of course, a flawed argument. A sane person can commit suicide in times of distress. While mentally ill people are more likely to commit suicide, sane people undergoing a lot of distress can choose this option also. Trans people are under constant distress. Not only because of a mismatch between their gender identity and body but also because of harassment.

They don't hear a voice in their head that tells them to kill themselves unlike schizophrenics. It has been shown that suicide rates fall once their family accepts them for who they are. The point is, they have a genuine source of distress causing them to pick suicide as an option very often. [10] The suicide rates therefore does not prove mental illness.

In conclusion, homosexuality and transsexuality are complex and interesting phenomena that are often misunderstood by the lay person. Education about these issues is there for important to free people from their prejudices.

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

THE DEATH OF RELIGION AND ITS MORALITY AS TECHNOLOGY ADVANCES.

I come from a deeply religious background and for a better part of my life I was schooled into religious dogma and mythology. When the scientific method is faceted in, we start asking questions to find out why some human action can be declared immoral yet another human behaviour is declared moral.

Humanism introduces the idea of free inquiry and we are encouraged to question everything in order to seek satisfactory answers. Humanists don't do good because they want to be rewarded for doing good or because they fear to be punished for doing bad.

Rather humanists do good because it's the rational thing to do since doing good is in its self humane. Therefore, if you brought your in my garage, the humanists n me tells me that I should fix your car not only to your satisfaction but to that desired standard in which I would be very comfort-

Humanism would imply that I practically offer social justice, offering the best services in my power that safeguards the life of people that will use that car. The advancement of technology and science has practically meant the death of old gods and old religions as we know them from the "holy" books and instead introduced another new meaning of religion and God from a scientific perspective. As science progresses, life span is prolonged and many diseases that hitherto were incurable can not be effectively treated and managed. And this is a big blow to religion because religion is premised on the concept suffering and a good life in heaven. In practical terms, science is answering many of the unknown questions that the framers of religion couldn't answer by the time they invented it. In other words, in today's world The individual has become the perfect meaning of God.

Old religions will gradually be left to mostly a people who cannot think for them selves and a people who hang on religion because of the economic benefits they derive from remaining believers. Religious consolation is dangerous to the advancement of societies.

It is important that such damaging beliefs continue to be bashed through critical thinking seminars and dialogues and public debates such as this'd ones advanced by HALEA . It is nonsensical to see a driver and passengers praying crying loud to God asking God to protect them in their journey instead of doing a thorough scientific inspection, tasting the level of engine oil, water,

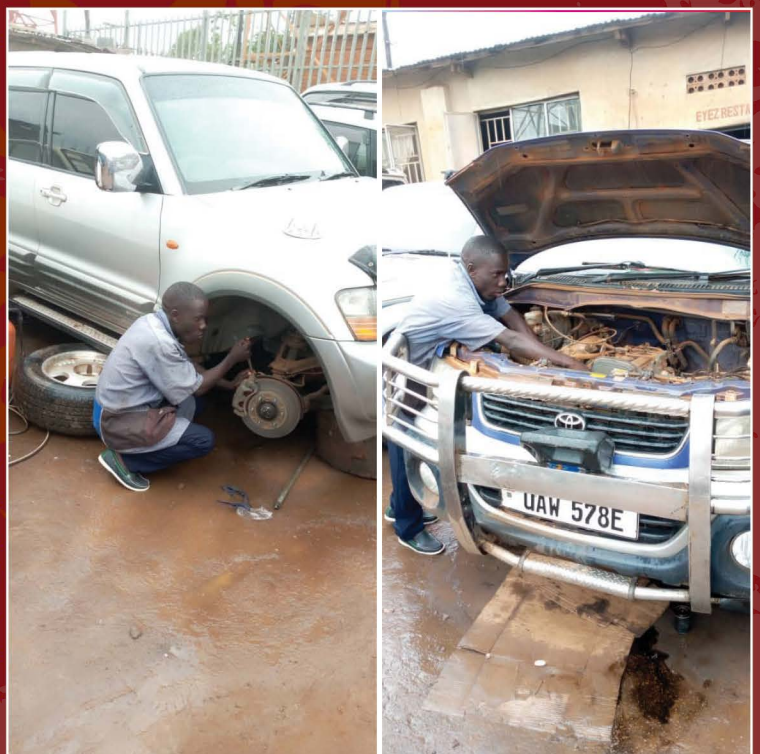
lights and ensuring that the break system is in good condition.
